RIGHT TO REPORT

If you, or someone you know, are experiencing sexual abuse, sexual harassment or any other type of abuse, Acadiana Center for Youth wants to know. We want you to report right away! Why?

- We want to keep YOU safe; it is our job! It is your right to be free from sexual abuse and sexual harassment.
- We want to conduct an investigation of the reported incident.
- We want to hold the perpetrator accountable for his/her actions.
- We want to provide YOU with relevant information and support services.

HOW TO REPORT

Acadiana Center for Youth offers multiple ways to report sexual abuse and sexual harassment. Reports can be made anonymously.

- Call Investigative Services – Dial 1 then 1 then 999 OR 1-(800) 626-1430
- Call Louisiana Ombudsman- Dial 1 then 1 then 4444 OR 1- (833) 462-0927 (Outside Reporting Agency)
- Call the Family Liaison - Dial 1 then 1 then 800 OR 1- (800) 594-3941
- Report to any staff, volunteer, contractor, medical or mental health staff.
- Submit a grievance or a sick call slip.
- Report to the PREA coordinator or PREA compliance manager.
- Tell a family member, friend, legal counsel, or anyone else outside the facility. They can report on your behalf by calling 1-(800) 626-1430.
- You also can submit a report on someone's behalf, or someone at the facility can report for you using the ways listed here.

VICTIM SUPPORT SERVICES

Acadiana Center for Youth has partnered with STAR to provide survivors of sexual abuse with emotional support services. To access these services, call STAR – Dial 1 then 1 then 1111 OR call 1- (855) 435-7827 (Rape Crisis Center). 1403 Metro Drive, Bldg. F, Alexandria, LA 71301

All STAR councilors follow Mandatory Reporting Laws. Services are FREE and CONFIDENTIAL.
