RIGHT TO REPORT

If you, or someone you know, are experiencing sexual abuse, sexual harassment or any other type of abuse, Acadiana Center for Youth and Acadiana Center for Youth at St. Martinville want to know. We want you to report right away! Why?

- We want to keep YOU safe; it is our job! It is your right to be free from sexual abuse and sexual harassment.
- We want to conduct an investigation of the reported incident.
- We want to hold the perpetrator accountable for his/her actions.
- We want to provide YOU with relevant information and support services.

HOW TO REPORT

Acadiana Center for Youth and Acadian Center for Youth at St. Martinville offer multiple ways to report sexual abuse and sexual harassment. Reports can be made anonymously.

- Call Investigative Services – Dial *999
- Call STAR at – Dial *1111
- Call the Family Liaison - Dial *800
- Report to any staff, volunteer, contractor, medical or mental health staff.
- Submit a grievance or a sick call slip.
- Report to the PREA coordinator or PREA compliance manager.
- Tell a family member, friend, legal counsel, or anyone else outside the facility. They can report on your behalf by calling (800) 626-1430.
- You also can submit a report on someone's behalf, or someone at the facility can report for you using the ways listed here.
